

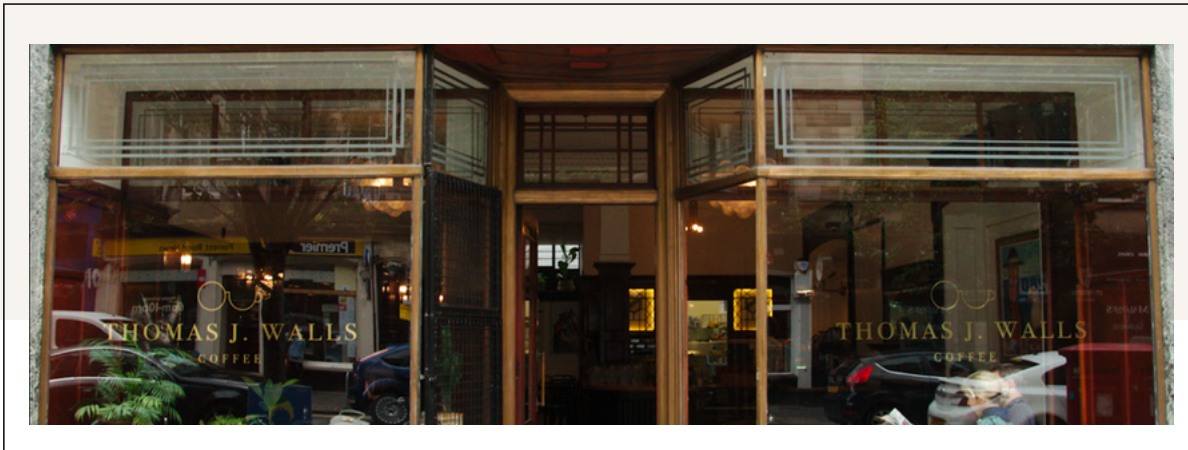


5 BEAUTIFUL CAFES TO VISIT IN EDINBURGH

👣 25 minute walk from Argyle Backpackers

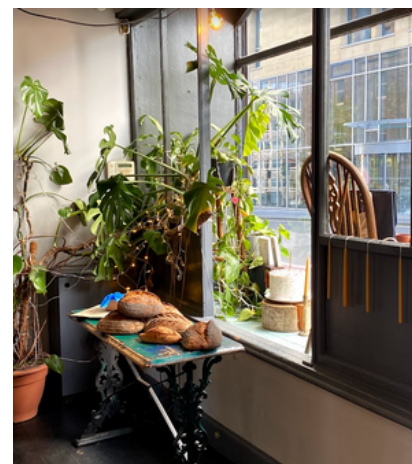
